**Strategic Plan Updates**

Regarding Goal 10, Objective 10.1:

A survey was developed to determine which agencies/counties are using UHF vs. 800 MHz vs. other frequencies, as well as determine MED8 compliance. The survey responses were received on 4/25/11, which represents approximately little over a 10% response. The responses are pending assessment for determining the measures specified in objective 10.1.

A new version of the EMS Communications Plan was revised and released (4<sup>th</sup> Edition completed March 17, 2011). Notably, it included "regionalized MEDCOM," incorporated the national channel naming standard, referenced other plans, introduced the Project 25 radio standard, and introduced chart showing relationships between plans and committees.

Partnering with AHCA to improve inspection procedures remains to be achieved.

Regarding Goal 10, Objective 10.2:

Improving agency access to training and education has been side-tracked with focus on the DOH PST Certification. This objective should be repeated in the next strategic plan with a timeline of 2012.

Regarding Goal 10, Objective 10.3:

Efforts to improving agency access to federal and state funding will become a focus shortly, starting with a standing agenda item of the EMSAC Communications Committee.
